







a. Pueblo Bonito (Judd 1964) The Oldest and Largest Pueblo in Chaco Canyon.








Figure 6. Alternating Squares And Circles A Family Of Designs Based On √2









e. Zaslow and Dittert's pattern model (1977: Figure 8).
































